But I retired at 64, a year before you, because I was looking after our kids. You did it at 65 as everyone, hahaha what a pity for you!

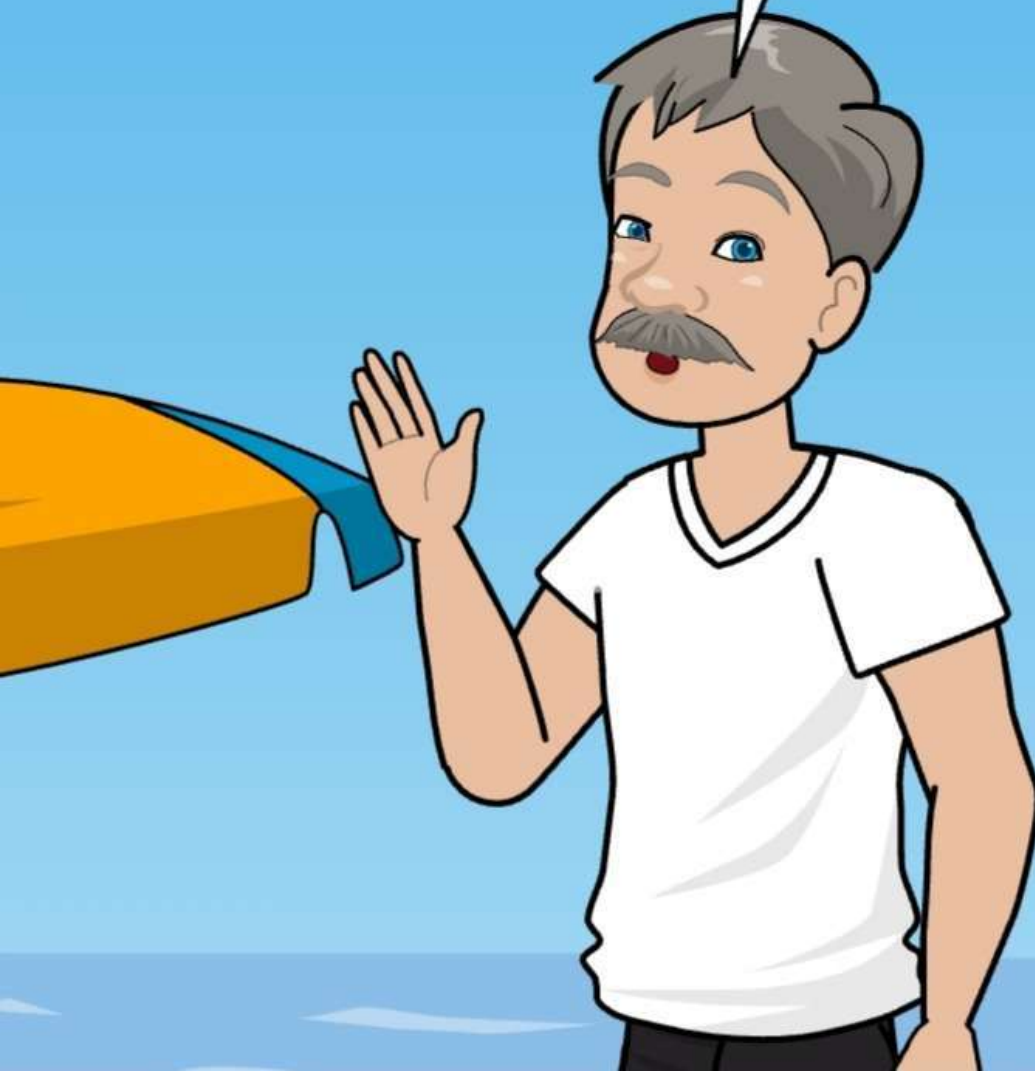
And not only that, you earn more than me as a nurse and I am a self-employed. In the end, you have a better retirement.

Have you ever thought that when our children are our age they will probably have five years left to retire?

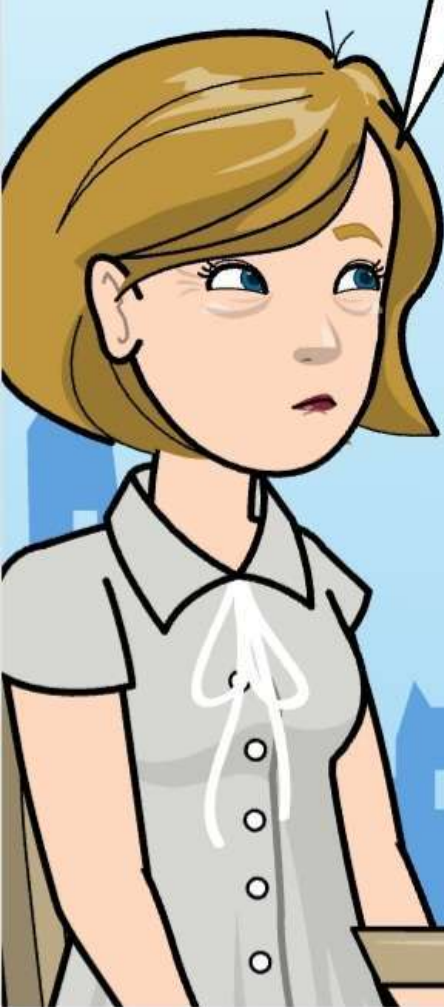



Taking into account the enormous decrease in the birth rate, the sustainability of future pensions will have an effect in the long term.
